Registering Upward

A player may be registered for a camp older than their age by as much as one year.
A player may not be registered downward.

Late Registration

Space permitting, late registrations will be accepted at a prorated fee until the start of the 3rd last day of any particular camp.

Volunteer Appreciation

If any member of a registering player's family has volunteered (without pay) 30 hours in support of their local school, community association, community sports team, or similar entity since September 2017, their registering youth is eligible for an appreciation discount. Contact the YAS Camps Director to receive this discount prior to registering.

Bursary Fund

YAS annually receives grants and donations to its bursary fund. Awards from the YAS bursary fund assist those who cannot afford all of their YAS fees. Since 1996, over \$460,000.00 in YAS bursaries has been awarded. A bursary inquiry should be made by a parent, guardian or other adult extended family member at least seven days prior to registration. Every inquiry will be welcome, handled only by the YAS Director, and will remain confidential.

Some of What You'll Get at YAS

As soon as you register, we will mail directly to you a detailed confirmation letter, a Canada Nutrition Guide, a SGI Safety Guide, and your numbered camp jersey.

At camp you'll learn and develop your basketball skills with top-of-the line equipment including multiple-sized leather basketballs supplied by Wilson Sports.

Each camp morning, you'll receive skills-development instruction and fun drills. Each afternoon, you'll take part in equal-play tournaments and games.

On the last afternoon of camp you'll join the ranks of over 13,000 who have gone before you since 1975 when you're awarded a "Saskatchewan Young Athlete" graduation medallion. You'll be a YAS GRADUATE.

A Camp Day

- 7:45 YAS staff on site to provide courtesy supervision for early arrivals.
- 8:30 Instruction and learning drills with ability sub-grouping and individual attention. Brief refreshment and snack breaks.
- 11:30 Supervised lunch break in the gym.
- 12:00 Equal play skills-reinforcement games. Brief refreshment and snack breaks.
- 2:00 Juniors and Bantam B move from gym to on-site recreational activity. (e.g. movie, or skills testing).
- 3:00 End of camp day for Bantam A / Seniors.
- 4:45 End of camp day for Juniors / Bantam B.

Note: Bring your own lunch, snacks & refreshments.

Multi-camp Program

Many youths maximize their skills development by attending multiple YAS camps during one summer. Their greatest skills improvement occurs during their 2nd, 3rd and 4th camps.

Within a particular age group each camp is the same . . . but different:

Explanation: During every camp, a core of fundamentals is learned, reviewed and drilled 20% of the time. During every camp, new skills unique to that camp are introduced and learned 40% of the time. During every camp, new, equal-play, and fun skills-reinforcement competitions and games are learned and played 40% of the time. Please note that no YAS camp is a prerequisite to another YAS camp.

Two age-level tournaments will be held at once: 16 & under and 14 & under, as of June 30th.

Every graduate from a YAS Bantam or Senior camp held during 2018 in Regina or Saskatoon will be eligible and invited to pre-register to be placed on a tournament team. If they wish, they may also each bring one or two guests who:
(a) are age 11 to 16 as of June 30, 2018, and
(b) have not attended any basketball camp in Regina or Saskatoon during July or August.
Exception: BSI camps graduates are eligible.

Every graduate of a previous summer's YAS camp who is unable to attend a YAS 2018 camp is also eligible and invited provided that they are age 11 to 16 as of June 30, 2018.

It is preferred that players pre-register for this tournament by email, telephone or text no later than 11:00 am, Friday, August 24th. Space permitting, last-minute registrations by telephone or at the gym may be accepted Friday afternoon and evening and Saturday before 10:00 am.

Some Tournament Features

YAS instructors who know players' from earlier camps will create competitively-balanced teams.

Each guest and previous year's YAS graduate who registers will receive a new numbered game jersey.

Every player will play equally in 8 tournament games, with at least 2/3 floor time in each game.

Eligible players can register at to play Friday and all-day Saturday or all day Saturday only.

Every player who completes the tournament will receive a Ironman Medallion for their age level (Champion, Consolation Winner, Finalist).

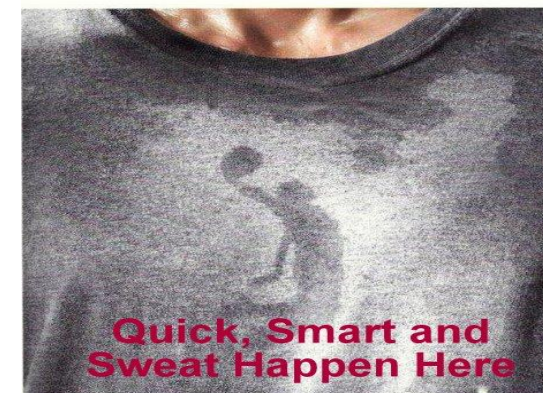
