## Fee Payment and Refund Policy

The full camp(s) fee(s) is due immediately at the time of registration. The registration will then be deemed finalized, and the player's detailed confirmation package including their numbered camp jersey will be mailed or couriered to the person who registered the player, i.e. parent, guardian, grandparent, other family member, sponsor or the player their self if senior or advanced camp age.

If the player is registered for a camp and that camp is cancelled by us, the person who registered the player will have the choice to either transfer to another YAS 2023 camp, or to accept a full refund.

If the player is registered for a camp and that camp is not-cancelled by us, and the player is withdrawn at least eight (8) days before the start of that camp, a 50% refund will be paid to the person who registered the youth.

If a player is registered for a camp and that camp is not-cancelled by us, and the player is withdrawn seven (7) or less days before the start of that camp, or does not show up for that camp, their entire fee will be forfeited.

A withdrawal or transfer must be received by email or otherwise in writing from the adult who initially registered the player.

## A Typical Camp Day

- 7:45 Courtesy reception for early arrivals.
  - 8:00 Gym opens and equipment ready.
  - 8:30 Instruction and learning drills with ability sub-grouping and individual attention. Brief refreshment and snack breaks.
  - 11:30 Lunch Break. Juniors and Bantams remain supervised in the gym.
  - 12:00 Equal-play skills-reinforcement games. Brief refreshment and snack breaks.
  - 3:00 End of camp day. Courtesy on-site supervision available until 3:15 pm.
- Note:** Bring your own lunch, snacks, water bottle and refreshments.

## Multi-camp Summer

Many players maximize their skills development by attending multiple YAS camps during one summer. Their greatest skills improvement occurs during their 2nd, 3rd and 4th camps of the summer. Within each age group each camp is similar, but different.

**Explanation:** During every camp, a core of fundamentals will be learned, reviewed and drilled 20% of the time.

During every camp, new skills will be introduced and learned 40% of the time.

During every camp, new, equal-play, and fun skills-reinforcement competitions and games will be learned and played 40% of the time.

No camp will be a prerequisite to another camp. A player may be registered in different age levels for different camp weeks.

**For Example:** a 14 year old may be registered for an Under 15 camp one week, and for an Under 17 camp another week.

## Bursary Subsidy Fund

YAS annually receives grants and donations to its bursary subsidy fund program.

A bursary inquiry should be made by a parent, grandparent, guardian or other adult extended-family member at least 14 days before they register their youth(s). Every inquiry will be most welcome, and will be treated confidentially and with respect by the YAS Camps' Director (a principal during the regular school year).

## Optional Hoodie(s)

A YAS-Logo hoodie may be purchased at the time of registration or at the gym for \$40.00 (delivery cost included). Otherwise, hoodies are available all year around for \$50.00.

## A What Makes YAS Special

YAS was founded in 1975 as a basketball skills-development school for girls by the Regina Church Basketball Association (RCBA) (aka "the Regina Church League") as a Saskatchewan Government International Women's Year grant project.

In 1976, the RCBA summer basketball school became Co-Ed and began drawing boys and girls players from across the province.

In 1983, the summer basketball school was incorporated separately from the RCBA as the non-profit charity, Young Athlete Saskatchewan (aka "YAS"), and expanded to Saskatoon.

Throughout its history, YAS has maintained and promoted the original RCBA "Church League" principles of respect, equal opportunity and teamwork-first for all participants regardless of gender, athletic ability, ethnicity and basketball-playing experience. At YAS camps there are plenty of competitions, often intense, but no MVPs, scoring leaders and all stars.

15,063 YAS camps graduates have come from across Saskatchewan, other-provinces and communities in China, Australia, Mexico, Europe, India, South America, and many American states. They learned basketball and leadership skills which they took back to their regular schools and communities where they excelled in basketball, in other sports, in academics, and as community leaders.

YAS is headed by Saskatchewan Professional "A" licensed TEACHERS who are also highly-accomplished coaches and administrators.

YAS uses the educationally-sound basketball rapid-skills-development curriculum developed by Masters and Doctoral Candidates at the Universities of Idaho, Calgary and Victoria.

YAS supplies all learning equipment including state-of-the art Wilson basketballs in men's (7), women's (6) and youth's (5) sizes for players to choose from plus competition vests, and numbered game jerseys for players to keep.

At YAS each camp player learns and plays equally in skills-reinforcement fun and exciting games where they develop their ability to focus during competitive game-pressure situations.

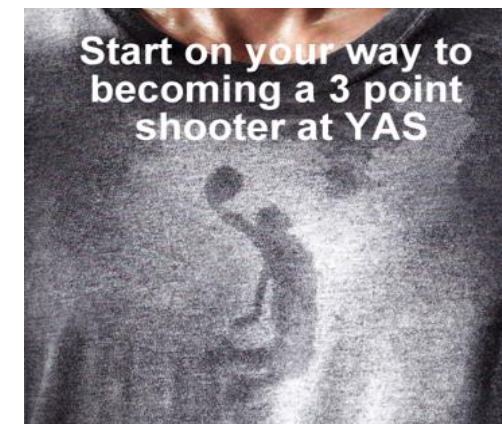
YAS staff members promote and exemplify proper nutrition and healthy-life styles.
